NFCC is a leader in North Fulton offering assistance to over **5,000** families annually. In 2011, food is distributed over **20,500**, over **2,000** families utilized clothing vouchers, and **\$1.2 million** dollars was expended for direct aid to our clients in need of financial assistance.

NFCC provided assistance to families living north of the Chattahoochee River, including the cities of **Alpharetta, Johns Creek, Milton, Mountain Park** and **Roswell**. Our goal is to prevent homelessness by providing food, emergency financial assistance, clothing, and other basic needs to the families we serve.

Although the demand for these services has increased significantly since its inception, NFCC continues to help **hands-on**, one family at a time.

**Emergency Financial Assistance:** NFCC provides direct aid for rent, utilities, medical, transportation and other basic needs on an emergency basis.

**Food Pantry:** NFCC distributes more than 9 tons of food and staple goods each week.

**Bilingual Services:** Services are available in Spanish, including translation, identification and access of other services.

**Family Enrichment Program:** NFCC helps families move towards financial stability and self-sufficiency by offering classes and workshops in money management, job readiness, ESOL, GED preparation, VITA Tax Assistance, health and wellness and life skills training.

**Holiday Assistance:** NFCC coordinates assistance to families during Thanksgiving and December holidays, a program that brings joy to those giving as well as receiving.

**Special Assistance:** Easter baskets in April; School Supplies in August; Winter Coats in October, and Donated Automobiles.

**Special Projects:** NFCC matches volunteers with service projects, i.e. yard work for seniors, minor home repair, fund raisers, food and clothing collections.

**Indigent Health & Dental Care:** NFCC works closely with public health, Grady Hospital, and private providers to secure access for indigent families. We match volunteer dentists with low-income families for emergency dental care.

**Advocacy:** NFCC works with the community and other non-profit agencies to advocate for unmet needs and increased access to services for low-income residents.
