

ENGLISH AS A SECOND LANGUAGE (ESL) CLASSES



North Fulton Community Charities offers 15-week ESL class sessions three times a year, free of charge to the North Fulton community.



Students are placed by level and may advance through five levels. Curriculum topics include education, health care, financial planning, and employment. Classes end with a celebration, and a Certificate of Completion is awarded to students maintaining attendance and progress requirements.

Students must be over the age of 18. Preference is given to area residents.
