



Job Searching on LinkedIn and Indeed: ***Tips and Things to Avoid***

General recommendations:

1. Build your LinkedIn and Indeed profiles. Make posts on a regular basis so your account gets picked up by the algorithm more and is more likely to be seen by recruiters/hiring managers.
2. Build a job search on LinkedIn and Indeed which are filtered to the area you are job searching in. For example, if you are looking for a remote job, set the filters to “Remote” or “Contract Remote” opportunities and set up email alerts to be notified when new jobs come in.
